Re: CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

Current Situation

As was identified by Provincial Health Officer; Dr. Bonnie Henry last week, we have seen a considerable spike in COVID-19 cases in BC. Yesterday afternoon produced 10,734 total cases – 1476 of those being active with 549 of those over the last 4 days.

On Vancouver Island, we've had a total of 235 total cases, with 17 active as of yesterday, with an addition of 3 new cases in the last 24 hours. We need to stay the course folks, as it is clear since our last reporting that we are still vulnerable to this disease and must continue our efforts to keep it at bay.

Flu Shot Clinic

We have secured a flu shot clinic from Central Drugs for mid November. We will know exact dates by the end of October.

Pandemic Pay Update

All documentation has been submitted, now we wait for the money to come in.

CARF Survey dates

We have received survey dates for CARF, which will be December 2nd – 4th, 2020. There will be more information coming in the next few weeks.
