Re: CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

Current Situation

Hi again, everyone – February slipped by very quickly, and it’s already time for another update.

As of Dr. Henry’s/Minister Dix’s briefing yesterday afternoon, there were 438 new cases of COVID-19 in BC – with 19 of those being on Vancouver Island. The highest concentration of cases remains in the Central Vancouver Island region, with 170 of the 291 currently active cases (per Island Health’s dashboard).

Since not much has changed in terms of average daily case numbers reducing (resulting in Public Health Orders from December staying in place), all we can do is also remain at status quo in terms of our vigilance towards protecting ourselves and others from this virus.

Vaccinations

Although more information was provided re the provincial government’s vaccination rollout plans on Monday morning, we are still awaiting some clarity as to when our persons served/staff may be vaccinated. We will let you know what we hear from Island Health in this regard as soon as possible.

In Conclusion...

Unless there are any significant developments, my next COVID-19 memo will come out the first Wednesday in April.
