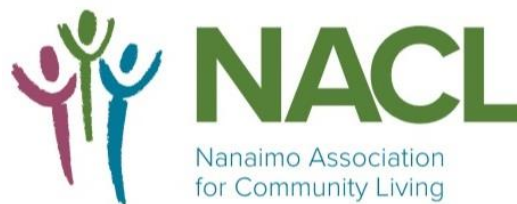

Re: CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

Current Situation

The number of COVID-19 cases in BC have spiked considerably over the last two weeks, with 738 new cases today (with yesterday having a record-breaking 941 test-positive cases) – and there are now an additional 21 cases on Vancouver Island after 11 more yesterday. The amount of active cases and hospitalizations are higher than ever, and we’ve seen a considerable increase of cases on the island during this period – many of them being here in the central region.

NACL has worked very hard to not only comply with PHO recommendations, but in some cases exceed them. With the latest recommendation of mandatory masks in indoor public places, we have been in front of the curve to ensure safety while providing an excellent level of care.

Staying the Course

I know I’m a bit of a broken record, but the message will be the same until a vaccine is widely distributed. Wear your mask, keep your distance, and don’t engage in unnecessary activities. There is light ahead, so please keep it up – and we’ll get through this safely together.
